LOOKING BACK

Seven individuals from Youth United for Community Action (YUCA) took a tour of the closed Romic facility on July 3rd.

LOOKING AHEAD

A two-day, on-line auction is scheduled for August 6th and 7th. Solvent recycling equipment, office equipment, storage containers, trucks and other items associated with Romic's operations in East Palo Alto and Arizona will be auctioned off. Equipment will be environmentally cleaned, as required by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, prior to delivery. The California Department of Toxic Substances Control, referred to as DTSC, is finishing up its *Response to Comments* for the draft Closure Plan for the former Romic facility. The draft Closure Plan outlines the preferred methods to decommission and dismantle the aboveground structures and test and clean the concrete pad that covers most of the site. The public had the opportunity to review and comment on the draft Closure Plan during a 45-day public comment period. As the title implies, DTSC's *Response to Comments* responds to all public comments received and shows how comments were considered, and where appropriate, incorporated into the final Closure Plan.

Bay Enterprises is cleaning up the former Romic facility in East Palo Alto. We are committed to performing this work safely, in compliance with all state and federal regulations, and with input from the community.
